The following is a selection of items covered by the tuition fees:

- Stationery (eg student exercise books, pens/pencils/textas, glue sticks etc)
- Classroom resources, materials, equipment, reference books
- Excursions and class activities (excluding optional extras such as SACSA sports carnivals)
- Electronic devices used in class including iPads, Chromebooks, and associated software licenses/subscriptions. (Note: the school provides all students in Foundation to Year 2 with individual one-to-one access to iPads and Years 3-6 a dedicated Chromebook for school use.)
- Campus Levy payable by Pilgrim School to per student to help maintain shared facilities
- Ambulance insurance cover (excludes pre-existing medical conditions)
- Camps (excluding the Year 6 senior camp - see note below)
- School Magazine - one per family (additional copies available for purchase)

Other Compulsory Fees

Parents & Friends (P&F) Levy: Each family is required to contribute \$85 annually towards the P&F. These funds are used to provide additional resources and support to the school.

Year 6 Senior Camp (Kangaroo Island): The cost of the Year 6 senior camp is much more significant than other school camps and a surcharge of \$650 per student is payable.

Uniform: Students are expected to wear the school uniform in accordance with the Pilgrim School Uniform Policy. Belgravia Apparel is the official supplier of uniform items and they have a shop on Campus. Purchases can also be made from their online store. Belgravia Apparel's price list and our Uniform Policy are available on our website.

Year 6 Seniors Jacket: \$99 each. Orders including payment are to be placed through Qkr during Term 4, 2025.

Application Fee: \$70 is payable on the submission of an application for enrolment (first child only).

Enrolment Fee: \$300 per student is payable to accept an 'Offer of Place'. This fee is available to be refunded or offset against the student's tuition fees when they complete their Primary schooling at Pilgrim School (ie at the conclusion of Year 6). It is otherwise non-refundable.

For the first student in a family enrolled at Pilgrim School a further \$250 deposit is payable which will be offset against their tuition fees when they commence school. This is non-refundable if the enrolment is withdrawn.

Discounts and Concessions

Sibling Discounts: Where one family has multiple children enrolled at Pilgrim School, the following sibling discounts apply to tuition fees:

2nd child – 10% 3rd child – 25% 4th child – 40%

Early Payment Discount: A discount of 5% of the tuition fees is available for payment received in full by Friday Term 1 Week 2.

Family Income Concessions: A concession on our standard tuition fees is available when Family Income* is below the following thresholds:

- Income below \$115,000 – Level 2 fees apply
- Income below \$95,000 – Level 3 fees apply
- Income below \$75,000 – Level 4 fees apply

**The term "Family Income" refers to gross family taxable income, being gross income prior to salary sacrifice/salary packaging, taxation, negative gearing, income allocation to trusts etc.*

Invoicing and Payment Arrangements

Annual Invoicing: All school fee accounts are invoiced in full at the start of the year – fee details will be loaded into our FACTS Management billing portal where families manage fee payment plans.

Payment of Fees: Parents/caregivers enter into a payment arrangement via the FACTS Management system online portal and will select a payment instalment plan that suits their cashflow needs. Options include full up-front annual payment (with a discount per above), or payment instalment each week, fortnight, month or term.

Alterations to the plan can be made during the year to accommodate changes in personal cashflow cycles or to allow for unexpected cashflow alterations – contact the Business Manager in relation to this.

Once the payment plan is established the FACTS system will automatically process payments from a nominated bank account or credit card.

There are no costs to families to use this facility – ie no FACTS plan fees or credit card surcharges. (Please note that FACTS charges a dishonour fee where scheduled payments do not process successfully, so it is important you have funds available on the scheduled dates.)

Voluntary Building Fund

The School is keen to continue to develop our buildings and facilities for the educational benefit of all students and maintains a **tax deductible Building Fund** to assist with this. All families are encouraged to contribute towards this – please contact the Business Manager to arrange a donation.

Notice of Student Withdrawal

In accordance with all enrolment contracts, a full term's notice must be given in writing advising of withdrawal of a student from Pilgrim School, otherwise one term's fees are payable in lieu of notice. This requirement applies to all students once enrolment has been confirmed.
